



2019-2020 Regular Scheduled Bingo Hours

****Important NEW changes in scheduling procedure****

Welcome to St. Catherine's Bingo! Bingo at St. Catherine of Siena School plays an integral role in subsidizing tuition for the families. We would like to take this opportunity to welcome families and remind them of their volunteer obligations to Bingo. Each family must complete 12 Bingo volunteer hours *each* school year (7/1-6/30), and of course we have a special place in our hearts for those families who elect to complete all 32 required hours at bingo!

Beginning with the 2019-2020 school year, to avoid conflicts and make sure that all three (3) Sunday nights work for you, families will be scheduling **their own** three (3) nights of bingo. On **August 1st** an email with the link to a regular bingo volunteer sign-up will be made available. Please select the three (3) Sunday's that work best for your family. We are asking that you only sign up for three (3) Sundays through the sign-up, and if you initially sign up for more than 3 Sundays, the Bingo Captains will remove you from the additional Sundays you may have signed up for. If you plan to complete all 32 volunteer hours at Bingo, we ask you to email us separately to coordinate (scsbingo@gmail.com) those additional nights.

Scheduling your own Bingo hours is a win – win! You get to pick the nights you are available, and an email will be automatically sent out to you from sign-up genius a little over a week before your scheduled night to remind you of your upcoming commitment. You will also still receive a reminder through the school's "Week at a Glance". If you cannot complete your scheduled bingo hours, you can use the sign-up genius to remove yourself from the conflicting night and find another open slot through sign-up genius. Each Sunday will have a limit of 8 bingo volunteer slots – so be sure to sign up early!

General guidelines:

Time—Each shift is from 3:45 to 8 (of course if you want to stay longer you are more than welcome or if you prefer 5:30 – 9:30 you can email us ahead of time to make that request!). When you arrive on your chosen Sunday, report to the kitchen in the cafeteria and make sure you sign in on the attendance sheet (so you get credit!) and check in with the captain on duty and we'll happily assign you to a job.

Jobs—It's pretty easy, we'll either have you sit at stations and sell what we call charity tickets (like scratch tickets) or help us sell bingo cards. In addition, you will be calling back winning card numbers and handing out prize \$ during the games. No training required – it's very easy!

Perks—complimentary dinner (pizza and drinks)

Additional Notes:

Dress is casual (comfortable shoes a must!).

No children are allowed in cafeteria while bingo is being held (Mass State Lottery Rule - no one under 18!)

During the school year (September – June), credit will only be given for ONE (1) volunteer per family on a single Sunday.

During the months of July and August, however, credit will be given for multiple volunteers per family on a single Sunday – so make it a family affair!
